**Children in Need**

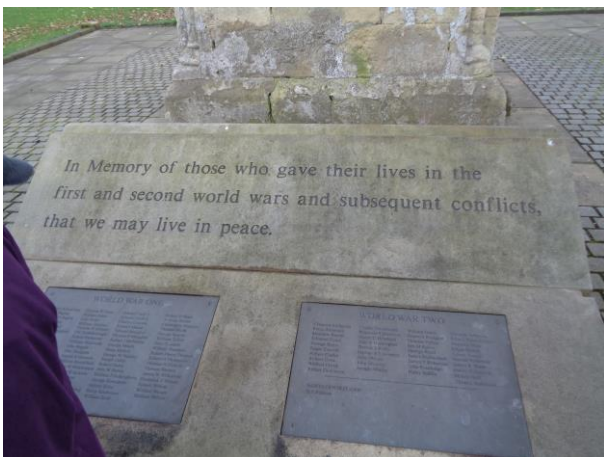
Next Friday 18<sup>th</sup> November is Children in Need Day. The School Council has been working hard on activities for next week. A letter has been sent home tonight about the day.
