PURPLE MASH

We have subscribed to Purple Mash, which is an educational website for children. It is a cross curricular resource covering Art to Science and all subjects in between. Your child can access Purple Mash from a home laptop, desktop or tablet. Purple Mash is a safe environment that does not require any downloading or allow interaction with people online and children cannot make financial transactions. Serial Mash, which is all about getting children to read for pleasure is included in the programme. Log-in cards will be sent home with the children.

PARKING
