Reminder for parents

Morning Routines

Only children who are attending breakfast club should be in school before 8.45am. It costs 50p per day and does not need to be booked.

All other children can arrive at school between 8.45am and 8.55am. There is no staff supervision at the front door until 8.45am so children arriving before 8.45am must be supervised by parents until staff arrive. As the bell rings on the yard at 8.55am all children should be in school by this time. Children arriving late are marked as late in the register.

End of School Routines

The school finishes at 3.15pm so children will begin to leave just after this time. Please appreciate that almost 150 children are leaving at the same time most nights. Infants(+siblings) are collected on the yard by the main door. Juniors are collected at the top gate. A few older junior pupils have parental permission to walk home but this is the parent's responsibility. All children should be collected from school by 3.25pm. Please contact the school if you have an emergency and will be late.

Visits and Visitors

Class 5 is currently working on a geography topic based on rivers. Part of this topic involves working in the local environment with Jill Essam and the Shocflood Team looking at flooding in our area. The children have been carrying out some local studies both at school and at Spring Gardens. This helps the children to understand how flooding occurs and precautions can be in put in place in areas at risk of flooding.

On Wednesday we had a performance of the children's story Tom's Midnight Garden by Image Theatre Company in school. The children were encouraged to join in with the play and music throughout the performance. A few children even dressed up as characters and performed on the stage.
