**SAFEGUARDING INFORMATION**

As a school, promoting the health and safety of our pupils is always a number one priority. We aim to ensure that all of our pupils are kept safe by promoting a caring ethos in a variety of ways including - promoting e-safety skills when children are using computers; promoting positive behaviour in and around school; teaching that cyber-bullying is unacceptable; promoting good health, hygiene and fitness; learning road safety skills; promoting inclusion and equality; talking about stranger danger etc. Some of these are promoted through specific curriculum initiatives such as visits to the Safety Carousel, school nurse visits, visits by the police, Bikeability, Road Safety talks etc and others are promoted through the school ethos and curriculum. This list gives a flavour of the types of activities we carry out to promote safeguarding but there are many more throughout the year.

We would also ask parents to continually help us promote safeguarding by updating us with new contact numbers, informing the school if someone different is collecting your child, promoting good computer use at home, ensuring our medication procedures are followed etc.
